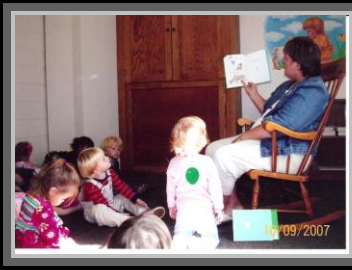
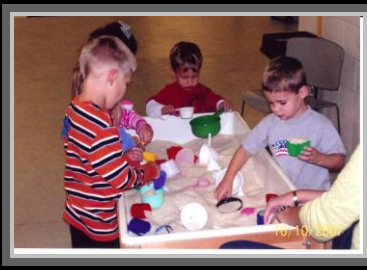

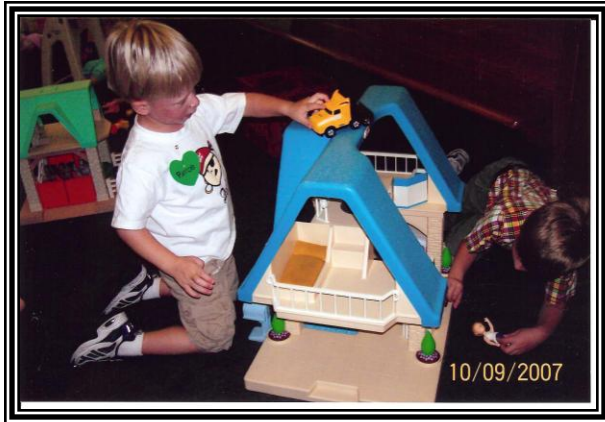

PDO's purpose is to provide loving, competent care for preschool children from 2 years of age through 4+. We believe that children can benefit from time away from their home routine by meeting and playing with other children in a loving and caring environment. Likewise, parents have a need for some time away from their children.

Our History at St. Mark's PDO began more than 20 years ago. Traditionally, PDO was a two day program, but last year, due to an increase in demand, we expanded to three days. This year we are operating five days a week, giving parents the option to enroll their child up to two days during the week. Also, recognizing a special need for children who graduated from our 2 to 4 year old program whose parents would welcome an extra year before or as a supplement to kindergarten, we added a special day for 4+ children. We have been fortunate to have the same director and teachers for many years.

Eligibility: PDO is a community service sponsored by St. Mark's Episcopal Church. Any member of the community may be eligible to enroll. A child does not have to be toilet trained to enroll in St. Mark's PDO.



The PDO schedule:

- Mid-September to mid-May
- Monday through Friday
- 9:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- Each day is a different class
- Substitute list for each day
- Children bring a sack lunch
- PDO follows the Glen Ellyn District 41 calendar (www.d41.dupage.k12.il.us)
- A PDO calendar for the school year is provided the first day of class.

PDO Registration is held in early spring. St. Mark's parishioners have priority registration, followed by those currently enrolled, and then registration is open to the community. Children register for one or two days.

Enrollment: To register a child, the parent must fill out a registration packet that includes a physical examinations form. These are provided by our Director and are also available in the church office. A nonrefundable enrollment fee of \$40 per child is required. The enrollment cost is \$50 for two or more children from the same family.



Fees: A fee of \$22 per session will be charged per child. If two children from the same family are enrolled, the fee will be \$40 per session; three children will be \$54 per session. A monthly payment is due on the first day attended each month. Checks are made payable to St. Mark's PDO.
